
INTERNSHIP FACT SHEET

Program Description

OASIS offers a limited number of paid internship opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students seeking practical experience in the environmental consulting field.

These internships typically last from four to ten weeks and are tailored to individual student interests. Goals and objectives are developed collaboratively between OASIS staff, the intern and the faculty sponsor from the student's academic institution. Selected students are assigned to OASIS work projects where staff mentors supervise and introduce them to a sequence of experiences and project-specific tasks to help them understand the nature and goals of the project, as well as environmental consulting in general.

In some cases, full-time seasonal employment may also be available upon internship completion.

Evaluation and College Credit

OASIS works closely with academic institutions allowing participants to gain credit for their internship. The number of credits is dependent on the length of the internship and dictated by the academic institution. Interns should provide the necessary paperwork prior to starting their internship for proper documentation with their institution.

Stipend, Housing, and Travel

Interns will be compensated on an hourly wage basis (including overtime). The hourly rate is dependent on experience. Interns are typically responsible for housing. For out of state interns travel compensation will be considered on a case by case basis dependent on length of internship, office location and project.

To apply to our internship program, use the online application form on our website. OASIS senior staff members will review your submission and contact you to follow up if an appropriate opportunity is available.

When to Submit

Internships are considered on an ongoing basis.
